What does "Shmoop" mean?

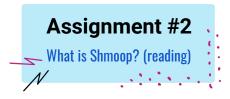
"Shmoop" is a yiddish term meaning "to move things forward a bit." And that's what we do at Shmoop - we move education forward.

Lesson 2: Navigating your "HOME" page

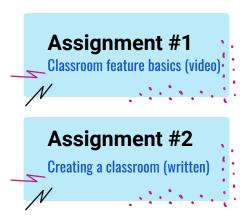


Get Familiar with your homepage!
